



SWIM SCHOOL ACCESS POLICY

- The Entry for swimming lessons is not permitted more than 1 hour prior to lessons, otherwise normal fees apply.
- Tor centres with turnstiles an access card will be issued.
- The swim school access card is to be used at the turnstiles each week to gain entry for swimming lessons as well as it marks the attendance to the lesson.
- If you have forgotten the access card, please see the swim school office or reception to mark attendance.
- For centres without turnstiles, please see reception to gain access and then ensure the instructor marks the student name as attending.
- Two parents/carers and any siblings aged between 5 and 15 years will be admitted free of charge for the duration of the class provided they are accompanied by a parent and do not utilise the facilities.
- For parent and baby classes, two adults are allowed in free, one to participate in the class and another as a spectator.
- During swimming lessons, the parent or carer must remain in the area of the class, within full view should the instructor require assistance.
- Other family members will be required to pay general admission charges.
